- b) Eric brought up a concern about a woman living in an apartment at Liberty Commons. She can't afford the rent and the management maintains that a smaller cheaper apartment is not available.

It was agreed that Eric should send out a letter to school principals in Sullivan County offering the anti-bullying program.
