

Care Center at Sunset Lake Visitation Fact Sheet

- All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms for COVID-19 this will be conducted Via signage posted at the reception desk and in the around the facility. This Signage will include symptoms of COVID -19 to be aware of and recommended actions for visitors.
- It is not recommended to visit for 10 days after exposure to someone with COVID -19 to protect the safety of the staff and residents of the facility.
- Visitors are no longer required to be tested in order to enter the facility, you must wear a mask at
 all times until further direction is provided. While not required testing does remain <u>HIGHLY</u>
 recommended since the county continues to be in the High Community Transmission level in order
 to protect our staff and residents.
- All visitors are required to wear a paper mask. At this time the community transmission rate is not low enough to constitute not masking. You will be required to wear a mask when in the facility.
- Visitors are strongly encouraged to have their vaccinations and boosters as recommended, but this is not required to visit. If you decline to disclose your vaccination status you must wear a mask at all times in the facility.
- Hand hygiene must be performed before and after visitation and between contact with residents (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- The use of surgical masks is required, the facility will provide if needed.
- Social distancing of at least six feet between persons is encouraged at all times when in the facility, especially in larger gatherings.
- Outdoor visitation is always preferred, even when the resident and visitor are fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- If social distancing cannot be maintained in the resident room other areas of the facility may be requested to be used for visitation for larger number of visitors.
- If a visitor tests positive for COVID-19 and has visited the facility within 2 days of their positive result or onset of symptoms they must notify the facility immediately so we can conduct contact tracing.
- The facility encourages all visitors to be fully vaccinated for COVID -19 to protect the health of the residents and staff members of the facility.
