II. <u>MINUTES:</u> E. Benson made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 9, 2022, board meeting, J. Diehl seconded, no one opposed, the motion was passed and carried.

IV. OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Neversink/Rondout Grant: See written report
 - Fiscal Year 23 includes a salary increase for H.S. per budget adjustment. N.Rajsz made a motion to approve the salary increase to \$64,200, E.Benson seconded the motion, motion was passed and carried.
 - A presentation of all projects completed was presented to the board.
 - Salary for B.C. was discussed. N.Rajsz made a motion to raise salary to \$20 per hour if 2-day work week or raise to \$25 per hour if works 4 days, J.Diehl seconded, motion was passed and carried.
 - The Neversink Rondout program wants to hire J.M. as an additional seasonal intern. G.Conklin made a motion to hire J.M. at \$18 per hour, E.Benson seconded the motion, motion was passed and carried.

- B. Program Updates:
 - Still waiting for results of the CRF grant submitted for Bashakill Vineyard project.
 - Flood mitigation Three projects started and four projects are in the works. Landowner contracts are being worked on.
 - CPFA-Working on the Hughson Drainage project.
 - Fish Program has started and orders have been coming in.
 - Technician position: Continued to discuss the hiring of a new technician. Will check with county and state on a job description and civil service technician list.
 - Tree & Shrub Program was a success. We had 166 orders. Discussed programs being easier and less time consuming if ordering was put online and accepting orders.

- A. Bank Statements: The bank statements were reviewed.
- B. CD Investment: Discussed cd rates at Jeff Bank and Catskill Hudson Bank. Will look into rates at other local banks.
