

## Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly (EISEP) when there is no place like home!

EISEP is a non-medical program for a personal and home care that can assist those who are:

60 years of age or older having difficulty maintaining themselves at home not receiving Medicaid.

**Case management** is provided to all **EISEP** participants to help them and their families determine what assistance is needed and to arrange services.

**In-home services** assist a person with daily activities. These may include assistance with tasks such as bathing, toileting, dressing, light housekeeping, laundry, shopping, and food preparation.

**Non-institutional respite** offers relief to families and others who are assisting an elder person by providing such in-home services or arranging for the EISEP participant to attend a social adult day program.

**Ancillary services** include items that help seniors remain safely in their home. Examples include purchasing needed equipment or supplies, or arranging home repairs or modifications. These services are provided on a one-time basis. Equipment may include a personal emergency Response system (PERS).

Participation cost is determined by income and housing expenses and is on a sliding fee scale.
